

**Student Bus Conduct**

Riding a school bus is a privilege and not a right. It is a privilege which each rider can keep by maintaining appropriate behavior and in complying with all District policies while waiting at the bus stop, loading, riding, and unloading. Proper conduct by the students contributes greatly to the safety of the pupil transportation program. With this in mind, the Superintendent or designee shall develop appropriate procedures for student bus conduct.

**Discipline for Violation of this Policy:**

Disciplinary action for violation of this policy or Student Bus Conduct Procedures may involve, up to and including, suspension and/or forfeiture of transportation privileges.
