

Personal Electronic Devices

The Board believes in the importance of technology in creating a conducive learning environment for students. Student use of personal electronic devices may be disruptive to the learning environment. However, personal electronic devices may be used for educational purposes under the direction of the administrator or designee. Such use must not disrupt the learning environment and shall comply with District policy Student Technology Use #3239.

Discipline for Violation of this Policy:

Any student found using technology in District classrooms or hallways during the school day without permission from the principal or designee may have the device confiscated until the end of the day. Subsequent unauthorized use may result in the technology being confiscated until the end of the school year or until a parent/guardian claims it.
