IDEA regulations require all students to participate in District and Statewide assessments. Special education students must be provided allowable accommodations for these assessments, if specified on their IEPs. (Adaptations/modifications change the test and invalidate the test scoring.) Selected Special Education Students are eligible to be assessed using the Idaho Alternate Assessment (IAA). Eligibility for the IAA is defined by the State Department of Education and considered by student IEP teams. The most current information as of September 2002 indicates the IAA will be administered one time per year in the spring for all students who qualify. Alternate assessments are not required for end of course tests.
