FLEX is an independent study program to be **completed at the Evening School site** under the guidance of a Boise Evening School certified teacher.

The **student works on one course at one time** and, with the successful completion of the course requirements (**at least 70 hours of documented course time**) can earn a credit for the class.

The student is placed on a contract by the FLEX Program teacher and has at least 70 hours to complete the course requirements for credit. **To be successful in the FLEX Program, the student must be motivated to earn credit, be disciplined to work independently, be able to read/comprehend at an acceptable level, and be able to spend the necessary classroom time to earn the credit.**

The FLEX Program has limited availability and is provided to assist students who have no other way to earn the credit. **A student is not usually eligible for the FLEX Program if the course is available in a regular classroom setting. A student is not eligible for the semester that he/she has been suspended from another school.** A Multi-disciplinary Team, a Hearing Panel, and/or an Area Director may grant exceptions. Any student who is withdrawn from school or who has not been in school should see a Transition Counselor or a Boise Evening School counselor for eligibility in the FLEX Program. Please check courses and space availability with Boise Evening School administrator.
