A work in an anthology

ENCYCLOPEDIA OR DICTIONARY (Entries in alphabetical order)

Author's last name, First. "Title of Article." *Title of Reference Book*. Edition. Print.

Signed Article

Unsigned Article

"Skateboarding." *The World Book Encyclopedia*. 2009 ed. Print.

MULTIVOLUME REFERENCE WORK

Author's name. "Title of article." *Title of whole work*. Editor. Volume #. Place of publication: Publisher, year. Print.

"Midnight's Children." *World Literature and Its Times*. Volume 4. Detroit: Gale, 2005. Print.

MAGAZINE

Author. "Title of Article." *Title of Magazine*. Date: Page number(s). Print.

Schendler, Auden. "Can a Ski Resort Really Be Green?" *Skiing*. Feb. 2009: 20-23. Print.

NEWSPAPER

Author. "Title of Article." *Title of Newspaper* [City] Date of publication: Page number(s), Edition (if given). Print.

Woodward, Tim. "Never Too Late for Field of Dreams." *The Idaho Statesman* [Boise] 26 Apr. 2009: C1+. Print.

PAMPHLET (Cite a pamphlet as you would a book.)

Teenage Drinking. Irving, TX: Mothers against Drunk Drivers, 2009. Print.

"Title of episode or segment." *Title of program*. Title of series if any. Name of the network. Call letters, city of the local station. Broadcast date. Medium.

FILM OR VIDEO RECORDING

Title. Director. Performers. (Optional.) Distributor, Year of release. Medium.
