



# Student Dress Code

## South Junior High School

### School Uniform Dress Code:

The School Board is permitted to adopt dress codes mandating the use of school uniforms. The purpose of the School Uniform Dress Code shall be to provide additional opportunities for increased school safety; to encourage students to experience a greater sense of school identity and belonging; to encourage an improvement in student behavior; and to encourage a high level of program participation.

### **Shirt:**

- Solid maroon/burgundy
- Polo: (hemmed) two, three, or four buttons at the top front with collar—short or long sleeve
- Students shall be required to tuck in shirts.
- Designs, emblems, insignias, monograms and logos are prohibited
- Under-shirts and t-shirts, if worn, must be white in color and can only be worn underneath the standard uniform

### **Skirts/Shorts/Slacks/Skorts:**

- Solid color: Khaki or black
- Style must be cotton twill or cotton blend (no jean style or material)
- Must be worn at waistline
- If pants have belt loops, belt must be worn; elastic waist is ok
- Designs, emblems, insignias, monograms and logos are prohibited

### **Skirts:**

- Solid color: Khaki or black
- Must be worn at waistline
- If skirt has belt loops, belt must be worn
- Length: Top of knee or longer
- Can be pleated, flat, or A-line



### **Shorts:**

- Solid color: khaki or black
- Must be worn at the waistline
- If shorts have belt loops, belt must be worn
- Length: No shorter than top of knee to four (4) inches above knee (length can be cuffed or not cuffed)
- Can be pleated, flat, or A-line

### **Skorts:**

- Solid color: khaki or black
- If skorts have belt loops, a belt must be worn
- Must be worn at the waistline
- Length: Top of knee to four (4) inches above knee (length can be cuffed or not cuffed)
- Can be pleated, flat, or A-line

### **Slacks:**

- Solid color: khaki or black
- Straight legs
- No elastic or gathered at the ankles. No slits in pants legs.
- Must be hemmed and length not to exceed top of shoe (hem can be cuffed)
- If pants have belt loops, belt must be worn
- Must be worn at waistline
- Parachute, wind, stretch/warm-up, and jean style pants are prohibited
- Capri pants are allowed
- Can be pleated or flat front

### **Belts:**

- Solid color and solid material: Black, khaki or brown
- Belts are mandatory when wearing slacks, skorts, skirts, or shorts with belt loops
- Belt buckles must be plain; standard buckle
- Appropriate length for waist size
- Design emblems, insignias, monograms, logos, holds, studs, etc..are prohibited

**Socks/Hose:**

- Solid color
- Designs, emblems, insignias, monograms, and logos are prohibited

**Shoes:**

- Shoes may be tie, buckle, or Velcro (tennis shoes are acceptable)
- Shoes shall be properly tied, if applicable
- Boots may be worn with pants only

**Pullovers/Sweaters/Sweatshirts:**

- Solid color: maroon, grey, or black
- Designs, emblems, insignias, monograms and logos are prohibited—  
excepting South Junior High approved (with South logo)

**Coats:**

- Coat/jacket/sweater may be worn as long as the uniform shirt collar is revealed under the coat/jacket/sweater (TRENCHCOATS are prohibited)
- Vests/jackets/sweaters/coats that zip/button may be any color and with or without hood
