

# Uniforms at South

## Questions & Answers

**1. What is the dress code?**

Please see attached dress code for South Junior High students.

**2. When do I need to begin wearing my uniform?**

The first day of school, August 28, 2006.

**3. What if financially I cannot afford to buy a uniform?**

Please see South counselors to obtain information/help in purchasing uniforms.

**4. What if I come to school without wearing a uniform?**

Students will not be allowed to attend classes out of uniform. The following options may be implemented:

- Parent will be called to bring uniform from home
- Missing part of uniform will be loaned to student for the day
- Student may be sent home if it becomes a discipline issue (insubordination)—if this is a repeat offense

**5. When/if my student leaves South, what do I do with my uniform/s?**

You may donate them to South, to be given to future students.

**6. How many uniforms will I need?**

This is a personal choice. Our study has recommended a minimum of three. The choices of clothing will allow for mixing and matching.

**7. What if I transfer to South during the school year? How long will I have to get a uniform?**

New students will be expected to have a uniform on their first day. Stores that we have communicated with will have uniforms in stock. (See below)

**8. What is the easiest and most economical way to get a uniform?**

Uniforms which conform to dress code guidelines may be purchased at any time and at the store of your choice. South will hold a uniform faire during August registration. The following vendors can provide appropriate items and have been generous supporters of the South uniform program.
