Make a mental note to add one more item to your shopping list this month. Boise Schools are partnering with OPERATION WISH BOOK to make new books available to children who don't have the pleasure of owning their own treasured books. Books are collected during November and are distributed in December to disadvantaged children. You and your child can participate in several ways. Your child can select and purchase some books to give from classroom book orders if they are in a classroom that participates in those programs. Or, they may bring a book purchased elsewhere to school and place it in the specially marked OPERATION WISH BOOK collection box. Rediscovered Bookshop at 7079 Overland and A Novel Adventure at 906 Main will give a 20% discount on books purchased for OPERATION WISH BOOK from their businesses. OPERATION WISH BOOK is a 501(c) 3 non-profit organization made up of area teachers who volunteer their time so needy children can have books to love that belong to them. All proceeds go to purchase books for children.
