Cold vs. H1N1 Flu

<u>Symptom</u>	<u>Cold</u>	<u>H1N1 Flu</u>
Fever	Fever is rare with a cold.	Fever is usually present with the flu in up to 80% of all flu cases. A temperature of 100°F or higher for 3 to 4 days is associated with the flu.
Coughing	A hacking, productive (mucus-producing) cough is often present with a cold.	A non-productive (non-mucus producing) cough is usually present with the flu (sometimes referred to as dry cough).
Aches	Slight body aches and pains can be part of a cold.	Severe aches and pains are common with the flu.
Stuffy Nose	Stuffy nose is commonly present with a cold and typically resolves spontaneously within a week.	Stuffy nose is not commonly present with the flu.
Chills	Chills are uncommon with a cold.	60% of people who have the flu experience chills.
Tiredness	Tiredness is fairly mild with a cold.	Tiredness is moderate to severe with the flu.
Sneezing	Sneezing is commonly present with a cold.	Sneezing is not common with the flu.
Sudden Symptoms	Cold symptoms tend to develop over a few days.	The flu has a rapid onset within 3-6 hours. The flu hits hard and includes sudden symptoms like high fever, aches and pains.
Headache	A headache is fairly uncommon with a cold.	A headache is very common with the flu, present in 80% of flu cases.
Sore Throat	Sore throat is commonly present with a cold.	Sore throat is not commonly present with the flu.
Chest Discomfort	Chest discomfort is mild to moderate with a cold.	Chest discomfort is often severe with the flu.

13th in World Xterra Adventure Games in Maui.

A maxed-out field of more than 500 athletes from 23 countries and 36 U.S. states competed in the 14th annual [XTERRA World Championship](http://www.xterramaui.com), which combines a one-mile swim in the Pacific Ocean, a grueling 20-mile mountain bike leg that climbs 3,000-feet on rocky, dirt-strewn trails on the lower slopes of Haleakala Volcano, and a 7-mile trail run along the beaches and lava formations along south Maui's scenic south shore. The race distributed \$105,000 in prize money to the top pros and was filmed for a one-hour TV show that will air across the country via national syndication starting in January of 2010. Highlights and full results can be found at www.xterramaui.com. The XTERRA World Championship is the final race in 100-stop series that travels to 12 countries and 36 states in the U.S.
