This program will offer students an opportunity to earn credits toward graduation requirements and to prepare for the coming year.

**Registration:**  
You should first consult with your school counselor beginning in mid-March to determine if these courses are appropriate for you to take in the summer.

Forms will be accepted from March 16th through May 29th.

**Cost:**

Registration Fee (non-refundable):	\$30.00
Boise Independent School District Student:	\$85.00 per credit (semester)
Out of District Student:	\$95.00 per credit (semester)

Each semester of each course is one credit. When your child signs up for summer school, the fee will be \$200.00 for both semesters (2 credits) for the Boise District students and \$220.00 for both semesters (2 credits) for the out of district students. For students who take one semester class, the total cost will be \$115.00 for Boise District Students or \$125.00 for out of district students.

**Please note: Full tuition and fees must accompany the registration form**

**Refunds:**  
A full refund will be available prior to the first day of class, 75% on the first day of class and 50% on the second day of class. No refunds will be made after the second day of class.

**IF A PROBLEM ARISES WITH YOUR CHILD'S REGISTRATION, A SUMMER SCHOOL STAFF MEMBER WILL CONTACT YOU. OTHERWISE, YOUR CHILD SHOULD ARRIVE AT TVMSC ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL. CLASSROOM NUMBER ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE POSTED THAT DAY.**

\*\*NOTE: These are all two semester courses. You must take the full 8 weeks of the course to receive credit for both semesters (a full year's credit).

\*\*Physical Education 8<sup>th</sup> grade (1<sup>st</sup> semester only – June 9 – July 2)

\*\*Health 8<sup>th</sup> grade (2<sup>nd</sup> semester only – July 6 – July 31)

\*\*These classes are NOT for high school credit.

\*All of the above courses will end with the District End of Course Exams.

\*Each class is for either the first or the second semester - EACH STUDENT IS ENCOURAGED TO REGISTER FOR BOTH SEMESTERS OF EACH MATH CLASS.

\* All of the above classes are taught at an accelerated level for students who have not previously taken this course.



## Student Policies and Procedures

Students will be held to the policies and procedures of the Independent School District of Boise City as communicated in "A Student's Guide to Rights and Responsibilities". Students should refer to this publication, available in their home school's offices for a full reference. Particularly relevant policies and procedures are detailed below:

**Attendance:** Students must attend 90% of the time to receive credit. Only two (2) absences (8 hours) are allowed in each session. This policy will be strictly enforced. If students have obligations such as camps or family vacations that would require them to be absent longer than two days, they should not register. If your child is absent, please call the TVMSC Office at 854-6802 to excuse the absence within 24 hours.

**Tardies:** Only six (6) tardies per semester are allowed. Students will be dropped from the class if they are tardy a seventh time. After 20 minutes, a tardy becomes an absence. Students should synchronize their watches with the TVMSC clocks.

**Discipline:** Dangerous and disruptive behavior is prohibited. Suspensions and/or removals from class because of violations of Boise School District policies will count against attendance. Incurring a major disciplinary violation may result in immediate removal from the program. Major disciplinary violations include, but are not limited to, insubordination, theft, vandalism, verbal and/or physical abuse, hazing, fighting, possession of illegal substances (including drugs, alcohol and tobacco), bomb threats and false fire alarms. Students cannot possess fireworks, weapons, matches or lighters on school grounds.

**Dress Code:** Clothes, tattoos, and/or accessories that are immodest, disruptive or gang related are not appropriate. Students clothing must cover their midriffs. **A good rule to follow is full front, full back and sleeves to the shoulder.** Unless otherwise authorized by the principal, hats cannot be worn during school hours and shoes are required at all times.

**Grades and Exams:** All End of Course exams will be administered on July 3 and July 31. Students must make arrangements to be present on those specific days. Midterm progress reports will be given to the students to take home in June and July for second semester. Final grades will be mailed home the week of July 7<sup>th</sup> for the first semester and the week of August 4<sup>th</sup> for the second semester. Student's grades will be sent to their home schools to be posted to their transcripts for the permanent record.

**Transportation:** Students and/or their parents are responsible for transportation to and from summer school. A summer use pass for the city bus is available. Please call Valley Ride at 336-1010 for more information. Skateboards and roller blades are not allowed on campus.

**Lunch:** Will not be available at the school. Students must bring a lunch and snacks if they are attending for a full day.

**Campus Restrictions and Parking:** Students may leave campus during break. Safety rules for the parking lot will be strictly enforced and students will be reprimanded and/or ticketed for reckless driving.

**Finances:** If a check is returned due to insufficient funds, the check must clear by the second week of school, or the student will be withdrawn. **Students removed because of attendance, tardy or discipline infractions will not receive a refund of tuition or fees.**

**Student Responsibilities:** Students are expected to respect staff, peers and property. Food and drink, with the exception of water in clear bottles, are not allowed in the classrooms. Cell phones and CD players are discouraged because of possible disruption and the potential for theft. If students bring them, they must be turned off and stored in the backpack while at the school. Because course expectations for summer school and the regular school year are identical, students should carefully consider their levels of commitment before registering.
