

Alternative Senior High Summer School 2009 at Frank Church High School

The Boise School District will again sponsor a senior high alternative summer program for **eligible at-risk students**. This program will offer students in grades 9-12 an opportunity to earn up to four credits in meeting graduation requirements.

ELIGIBILITY

- Students must meet the Idaho State department of Education Eligibility requirements. (See page 5 of this application form).
- Students must have been in 9th grade or higher during the 2008/2009 school year to attend the Senior High Alternative Summer School.
- Students graduating summer 2009 must attend the **Alternative** program.
- Student transcript and current schedule must be attached to the application.**

TRANSPORTATION

Bus transportation will be provided for both a 7:40 a.m. arrival and 4:00 p.m. departure. *No school bus will be available at noon, but there may be a city bus stop nearby. Valley Ride can be reached at 336-1010.*

POLICIES

ATTENDANCE

Students must be in class at least 90% of the time to receive credit. Only **two days** of absence (8 hours) are permitted during the 19 days of class each semester.

TARDIES

Students are expected to be in the classroom when the bell rings. Upon receiving a **sixth tardy**, the student will lose credit for the class. A tardy becomes an absence after 20 minutes.

DRUG-FREE CAMPUS

Each student is required to sign a **drug-free agreement** as part of this application. Students must refrain from smoking during the entire school day anywhere on campus.

CLOSED CAMPUS

Full-day students must stay on school campus during the school day, including lunch period.

FIELD TRIPS

Any field trip scheduled by the classroom teacher is considered a class activity and students are required to attend. If a student arrives late to school and the class has already departed, he/she will be counted absent from the class.

TO REGISTER:

- **Read** the above policy carefully.
- **Detach** the first four pages for your records.
- Together with your counselor and your parents, **complete the information** on the following pages.
- **Students must have been in 9th grade or higher during the 2008/2009 school year to attend the Senior High Alternative Summer School.** Priority will be given to those whose registrations are received prior to the **May 22nd deadline**.

SENIOR HIGH ALTERNATIVE SUMMER SCHOOL POLICIES & PROCEDURES SUMMARY

ABSENCES: 90% attendance is required by District Policy. **2 DAY LIMIT!**

TARDIES: LIMIT OF 5

DRESS/GROOMING:

- Modest and appropriate for school setting.
- Shirt and shoes must be worn at all times.
- Hats may not be worn in the building.
- Clothing/Jewelry cannot advertise alcohol, drugs, tobacco, gangs, or sex.
- No electronic device usage in the classrooms
- No backpacks allowed
- No sunglasses, chains, trench coats

CLOSED CAMPUS:

- Students may not leave campus until the end of class(es) without a permit-to-leave.
- The parking lot is off limits – vehicles must remain locked until class(es) are over.
- Visitors must check in with security officer and main office. No visitors in classes.
- Parking in the front parking lot only
- Break and Lunch Boundaries are cafeteria/main hall/courtyard behind cafeteria

INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT:

- Any conduct disruptive of the education process is prohibited. Hard work and respectful behavior toward all teachers and classmates is required.
- Any conduct which infringes upon the rights and property of others is prohibited. This includes fighting, hazing, harassment and theft.
- No other food or drink in classrooms besides water.

APPROPRIATE LANGUAGE must be used at all times.

PROPER BUS / CAFETERIA CONDUCT IS EXPECTED AND REQUIRED – all school policies apply to school busses and the cafeteria. Drivers and cooks will be treated with respect. Students are required to *pick up after themselves* and clean up any messes that are left behind.

DRUG / ALCOHOL / SMOKE FREE CAMPUS – possession, use, or sale of any drugs, lighters, tobacco, or alcohol, will not be tolerated.

FIELD TRIPS:

- Students are required to participate in all class activities including field trips.
- Children are not allowed to accompany parents on field trips.
- Students who arrive too late to participate will be counted absent for those hours.

ZERO TOLERANCE FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- *Weapons (and look-alikes), knives, pagers, cell phones(except at lunch and break)*
- *Gang related behavior/ attitude/ dress*
- *Fireworks*
- *Bomb threats or setting off fire alarms*
