SUMMER SCHOOL POLICIES

ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to attend summer school every day. No more than 2 absences per class are allowed during the session.

TARDIES

Students are expected to be in the classroom when the bell rings. Upon receiving a sixth tardy, the student may/will be dropped from the class.

A tardy becomes an unexcused absence after 20 minutes. Two unexcused absences will result in dismissal from summer school.

DRUG-FREE CAMPUS

Each student is required to sign a **no-smoking agreement** as part of this application. Students are not allowed to smoke, have any smoking paraphernalia or any other drug on campus.

CLOSED CAMPUS

Students must stay on school campus in designated areas during the school day, including the lunch period. Students are not allowed to leave campus after they have arrived. A permit to leave may be obtained in the office at the request of a parent/guardian. Students are considered on school grounds from the moment they get off the bus.

ZERO TOLERANCE

The following items are forbidden at summer school:

- weapons (and look a-like weapons)
- cell phones and pagers
- gang related behavior and dress
- drugs and drug paraphernalia
- alcohol
