



Student Internet Access Restriction Form

Please read the following carefully:

- The Internet provides a dynamic tool for accessing valuable content and resources to support student learning and achievement.
- Because the Internet is a global electronic network, there can be no absolute control of its users or content. The Internet and the available resources in its global electronic network may be erroneous, out-of-date, or illegal and may be considered offensive, controversial or sexually explicit.
- The Boise Independent School District makes every effort to insure that our students are protected from exposure to Internet materials that are harmful, inaccurate or explicit. The District maintains a system of Internet content filtering devices and software controls that meet federal standards established in the *Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA)*.
- As with other public institutions, we acknowledge that decisions regarding a student's access to and use of the Internet are the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.
- If you wish to have the District restrict your child from use of the District's monitored Internet connection, please complete the form below and submit it to the building administrator at the school(s) your student attends.
- A new request form must be submitted to each school on a yearly basis.
